Dear Students, Parents, Guardians and Carers,

Today the students will have received a booklet with the Mock Exam information and timetable for January 2025. Within the booklet is a timetable for ALL the mock exams that we will be facilitating across the Upper School. These mocks will be run following regulations and offering access arrangements as assessed and agreed with individuals.

During the first week **class 12** students are only expected to attend school for their mock exams and will have no formal timetable unless specific arrangements have been made. Please ensure that you arrive at school to register in reception **at least half an hour before the actual start time of your exam**. You will be expected at the gym 20 minutes before the exam to go through checks and instructions before being taken into the gym for the exam 15 minutes before the start time. Late candidates cause unnecessary stress and concern, not only to the staff running the exams but also to other candidates. If you are unwell and unable to attend, please make sure that you have informed both attendance AND reception at least half an hour before the exam.

**Class 10** students will be following their usual timetable with their mock exams incorporated into this. A printed copy of this has been inserted into your booklet. If you are unwell and unable to attend, please make sure that you have informed both attendance AND reception in good time.

All candidates should ensure that they arrive promptly to each exam, with the correct equipment needed. It is the responsibility of the student to be organised and prepared as best as possible in order to do their best. We are there to support you along the way, keeping you informed and confident. It is our hope, that by sharing all this information well in advance and through addressing any concerns in good time, you will be in the best possible space.

### PAST PAPER Practice

Like riding a bike, procedural memory enables us to remember how to do things without even thinking about it if we practice enough.

The long term memory is based on visual and meaningful content, not words.

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# Warning to Candidates

- 1. You **must** be on time for all your examinations.
- 2. **Possession of a mobile phone** or other unauthorised material **is not allowed** even if you do not intend to use it. You will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification from the exam/qualification.



# JCQ Al and Assessments A quick guide for students

### What is AI?

AI stands for artificial intelligence and using it is like having a computer that thinks



Al tools like ChatGPT or Snapchat My Al can write text, make art and create music by learning from data from the internet, but watch out – they can also make things up and be biased

### How can AI be misused in assessments?

Al misuse is when you take something made using Al and say it's your own work.

# THIS IS CHEATING!

How do I make sure I don't misuse AI?

### 💽 Know the rules

- You're **not allowed** to use Al tools when you're in an exam
- Your teachers will tell you if you're allowed to use AI tools when doing your coursework – the rules will depend on your qualification
- Even if you're allowed to use Al tools, you can't get marks for content just produced by Al – your marks come from showing your own understanding and producing your own work
- Reference reference reference! If you're allowed to use AI tools, you must reference them clearly
- Name the Al tool you used
- Add the date you generated the content
- Explain how you used it
- Save a screenshot of the questions you asked and the answers you got

### Declare it's all your own

**work** – When you hand in your assessment, you have to sign a declaration. Anything without a reference must be all your own work. If you've used an AI tool, don't sign the declaration until you're sure you've added all the references

### What happens if I misuse AI?

If you've misused AI, you could lose your marks for the assessment – you could even be disqualified from the subject.
